Living History Day @ White Hill Mansion

On December 13, 1776, British General William Howe placed Hessian Colonel Carl von Donop in command of the forward garrison of Trenton. Leaving the actual command of Trenton in the hands of Colonel Johann Rall, Donop instead was directed to encamp in Bordentown. Donop had under his command a force between 2,400-3,000 troops that was separate from Colonel Rall's 1,400 mixed Hessian and British troops at Trenton.

Encamping as one proved to be impossible with a force this size so Donop moved detachments across the countryside east and south of his position at Bordentown. One of those detachments knocked on the door of the home of the widow Mary Field and demanded that she let them stay...
